Question and Answers About – WOOD FENCES

Q. What kind of wood do you use?

A. We use 1 X 6 pickets and 2 X 4 rails (**ALL WESTERN CEDAR**)

Q. What about **treated** 2 x4s, Do you use them?

A. NO, unless the customer ask for it. **Treated wood will warp and bend out of shape when the sun dries it out.**

Q. Do you concrete your post in?

A. YES. We dig the holes about 10" diameter and 2 – 3 feet deep and filled with concrete.

Q. What kind of nails do you use?

A. We use galvanized ringshank nails. Once they are in, they do not come out very easily and they do not rust streak your fence as bad.

Q. What kind of post do you use?

A. We use heavy galvanized 2 ½" post or cedar 4 X 4's.

Q. Tell me the difference between the types of wood used.

A. The best wood is Western Cedar. Under normal conditions it should last up to 20 years.

Next is Spruce or Whitewood. It will last from 5 to 9 years.

The bottom of the line is **Treated wood. It warps, bends, and cannot take the Texas heat.**

Q. Do you have a warranty?

A. Yes, 30 days, if we install Western Cedar and it is something we did wrong installing the fence. (See #3 on the contract/estimate)
